1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

2 1. Defendant Director of Licensing Liz Luce and any persons acting on behalf of the
3 Department of Licensing shall:

- 4 a. promptly resume processing applications for alien firearm licenses;
- 5 b. issue alien firearms licenses to otherwise qualified applicants notwithstanding
6 the Department's or any local law enforcement agency's inability to perform or
7 complete a background and/or fingerprint check required by RCW § 9.41.170.
- 8 c. upon application, renew or issue alien firearm licenses to Plaintiffs Adrian J.
9 Coombes, Philip Grady, and such other lawful permanent resident aliens, including
members of Plaintiffs NRA and SAF, who may apply pursuant to RCW § 9.41.170 if
they are otherwise qualified for licensure.

10 2. There being no objection by the enjoined parties to the entry of this order, and there
11 being no evidence suggesting that the enjoined parties will incur any costs or damages as the
12 result of being wrongfully enjoined, it is proper that the moving party gives security in the
13 amount of \$0.

14 3. Plaintiffs have abandoned their request in this motion for an injunction against
15 Defendant Paul D. Ayers, City of Issaquah Chief of Police, and no injunction or other form of
16 relief is granted against said defendant.

17 3. Unless repealed or modified by order of this Court, this Order shall remain in full
18 force and effect until: (a) a final judgment is entered following a trial of this case on the
19 merits; or (b) dismissal of this action.
